Fall

3A: Pathophysiology with application of nursing caring concepts to care of child, adult, and elderly clients. Includes cultural diversity and ethnic considerations, disorders in men & women's health, musculoskeletal system, degenerative nervous system, liver, integumentary, respiratory, hematological, and vascular systems. Emphasis on nursing interventions.

3B: Practicum; applies nursing caring concepts to clinical practice of nursing in an acute hospital setting. 3B presents students with advanced nursing skills, (IV starts, central line care...). Students provide care incorporating cultural relevance to clients with a variety of health problems.

NRAD 2D Data Decision Making

Emphasis is on the nurse's role relative to interpretation and management of data related to medications and diagnostic testing.
